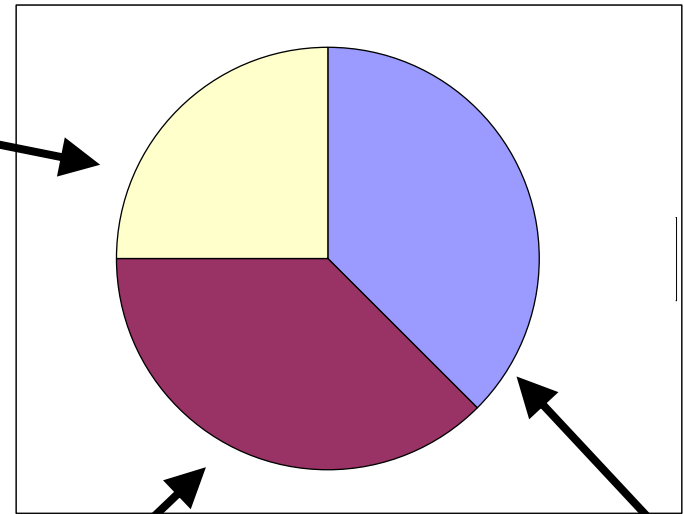

'What led your decision to enrol?'

25% were already working in the area "I realised some of the service development work I had been doing could count towards the module"

40% of replies said modules they were doing were based on "personal area of interest"



40 % said they wanted further training "Growing role in this area"

What do think about the information available about the HTS?

"information on BAA website - very useful", "very clear and concise" and "clear and helpful"

"information regarding the pre-requisites is unclear as I do not have a BSc in Audiology"

One person commented that on the website information about the new modules to be launched was not clear

"How was the registration process?"

- "relatively straight forward"
- "an easy process, but took quite a long time for confirmation"
- "no problems - I followed the instructions!"

Have you encountered any problems getting appropriate supervision?

- No respondents reported any problems
- Getting supervision was ok, but "finding suitable sessions when we're both free is less easy"
- "one of the benefits of the HTS as opposed to CAC is that more senior grade audiologists, rather than just scientists, were actively involved in my training. This made my training much more flexible"
